Dear Supporter,

You may recall that following pressure from this campaign (and the resulting press coverage) the National Park Development Management Committee (DMC) is planning a site visit to see the Bettws Newydd development. This should, we think, have happened long ago.

This note is to tell you the details that we have about this visit, and to encourage you to attend.

1. The visit will take place this coming Monday, 30th March, at approximately 10:30 am
2. The objective is for the DMC to view Bettws Newydd “both on site and from surrounding viewpoints” and the committee will be willing to hear representations from those present.
3. Anyone interested is welcome to come. We would like to encourage as many of you as possible to attend, to show the strength of opposition to this building and the new planning application.
4. Please gather outside Bettws Newydd (by the stile) at 10:30 am.
5. It is up to the Chairman of the DMC to decide who will get to speak to them. In case you don't get to speak you may want to think how to make it clear what your views are. (We think it would be acceptable to show signs or placards, but we don't want to encourage an unruly gathering!).
6. We have been told that the visit will go ahead regardless of the weather.
7. The National Park has told us they have not yet found out from the owner what access to the site he will allow.
