

New Bettws application is expected

THE saga surrounding a Newport house branded an 'eyesore' by residents continues, as a new planning application is expected.

Bettws Newydd, a replacement house on the Parrog, has been at the centre of controversy for

months. The site was granted planning permission in 2006, but was built bigger than the approved plans.

The owner faced the possibility of demolishing the house and rebuilding it after retrospective approval was refused.

However, Pembrokeshire

Coast National Park Authority decided to approach the owner to discuss ways of bringing the existing building in line.

Following meetings with the applicant, the authority says a further application to finish the dwelling is expected to be submitted

before Christmas.

A national park spokesman said: "Any application received will be considered at the next available meeting of the development management committee once all the statutory and local consultations have been completed."
