I refer to my previous letters advising that appeals have been made to the National Assembly for Wales regarding the refusal of planning permission and the issue of an Enforcement Notice by this Authority on the above site.

The Appeals will be dealt with by means of a Public Inquiry and will be held on 20th, 21st, 22nd, 26th & 27th October 2010 at the Newport Memorial Hall, West Street, Newport, Pems, SA42 0TD and will commence at 10.00 a.m. daily.

Limited parking is available within the site. Access to the building for the disabled is possible and there are disabled toilet facilities available.

It is open to the Secretary of State to grant planning permission. Interested parties may attend the Inquiry (personally or through a representative) and, at the Inspector's discretion, present any evidence they may consider should be put before him or give their views on the possible grant of planning permission, or, if they cannot or do not wish to attend the Inquiry, may present evidence or give their views in writing. Should you wish to use the Welsh Language you should advise the Inspectorate prior to the date of the Inquiry so that arrangements may be made.

Copies of this Authority's Pre-Inquiry Statements and other associated documentation will be available for inspection during normal office hours at the National Park Offices, Llanion Park, Pembroke Dock.

The Inspector will send a copy of the decision letter on the appeal only to those who ask for one, or who spoke at the Inquiry or alternatively the Inspector's decision can be viewed on the planning portal. The case can be searched for and then all available
